CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

“Excellence is not a singular act but a habit. You are what you do repeatedly”

With this belief, a set of guidelines in the forms of rules and regulations are framed for the students. These guidelines act as the refining fires helping the students to emerge as confident, promising and polished individuals.

- ◆ All students must come to school in time.
- ◆ The bell before assembly is a signal for the students to go to the assembly.
- ◆ Change of classrooms between periods should be done in silence and in an orderly manner.
- ◆ Shouting and whistling is not allowed in or around the school building.
- ◆ Other than text books or library books,no books or magazines should be brought to the school without prior permission.
- ◆ It is not advisable to bring to school valuable articles like expensive watches,fountain pens or any jewellery. The school is not responsible for any lost.
- ◆ Care must be taken of the school property and no one is allowed to scratch or spoil the desks and chair or damage any school furniture, write or draw anything on the walls or in any way damage any article belonging to
- ◆ Damage done even by mistake or accidentally should be reported immediately to the class teacher/Prefect/Principal or Vice Principal.
- ◆ Students who come to school under the care of guardians/servants should not leave the school before they arrive to take them.In case of delay, they should report to the school office.
- ◆ Students should be very polite wherever they go. They should always Know that the school is judged by their behavior and conduct.
- ◆ All students should greet their teachers whenever they meet them. No students should use foul language against teacher, visitor or guest of the school.
- ◆ The school reserves the right to terminate any student whose conduct is bad example for other children.
- ◆ During periods no student is allowed to leave the class without valid out pass.
- ◆ All school representatives / students should wear their respective badges / identity cards daily.
- ◆ Students must come to school in neat and clean uniform only. Scribbling on it or its improper wearing is actionable.

FEES-

- ◆ Annual fees are to be paid in four instalments.It must be deposited till the 10th of the scheduled month. In case the 10th is holiday,fee should be deposited before. After the 10th a fine of Rs 10 per day will be charged.
- ◆ Fee structure enclosed along with the registration form details the fees for the relevant academic session.
- ◆ Fee submission should be done in the designated bank only.
- ◆ Fees deposits are subject to revision from time to time.
- ◆ On the withdrawal of candidature, the paid amount related to admission and annual fees will not be refunded.
- ◆ The receipt obtained during payments should be preserved by the parents/guardians and should be produce as proof of payments, if needed.
